Certificate of Catholic Practice for Secondary Schools

I have been in contact with Dawn Pace at St Bartholomew's who has assured me that if your child is in Year 6 and requires a certificate of Catholic Practice, that these can be obtained from her. Please email her at dawnpace@rcdow.org.uk to request this, then complete all of the documents required. Fr Francis will return on 16th October and she will ensure that he signs them and she will then contact you to tell you they have been completed.

<u>School Applications:</u> Parents of children due into Reception in September 2023, will need to apply for a place this term. The on-line application system opens on **1st November 2022 and closes on January 15th 2023**. Anyone applying to St Adrian's must also complete our own SIF form. Although a certificate of Catholic practice is preferable, it is **NOT** essential for securing a place. Please contact the office if you have any enquiries. Could I also ask for you to spread the word to other families that are not part of our St Adrian's community to come to the open mornings to have a tour of our great school.

<u>Secondary Transfer</u>: Year 6 parents should have received information about secondary school open evenings. All applications must be made initially through the online admissions system. If anyone does not have access to an online application please let me know. On-line applications opened on **September 1**st **2022 and must be made by October 31**st **2022.** Voluntary aided schools (eg Loreto, St Michael's, Nicholas Breakspear, Townsend) will also have their own Supplementary Information Form (SIF) which must be completed and returned to the individual school. I am happy to see anyone who wishes to discuss their application or needs assistance with completing the forms. Please contact the office for an appointment.
