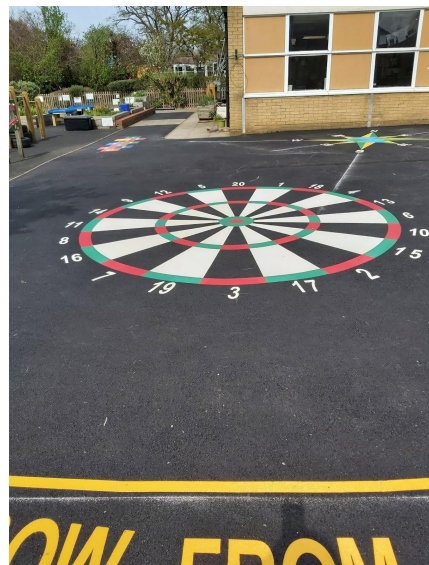
All of these large projects can only take place with your help. So thank you so much for your continued support and donations to the building fund.

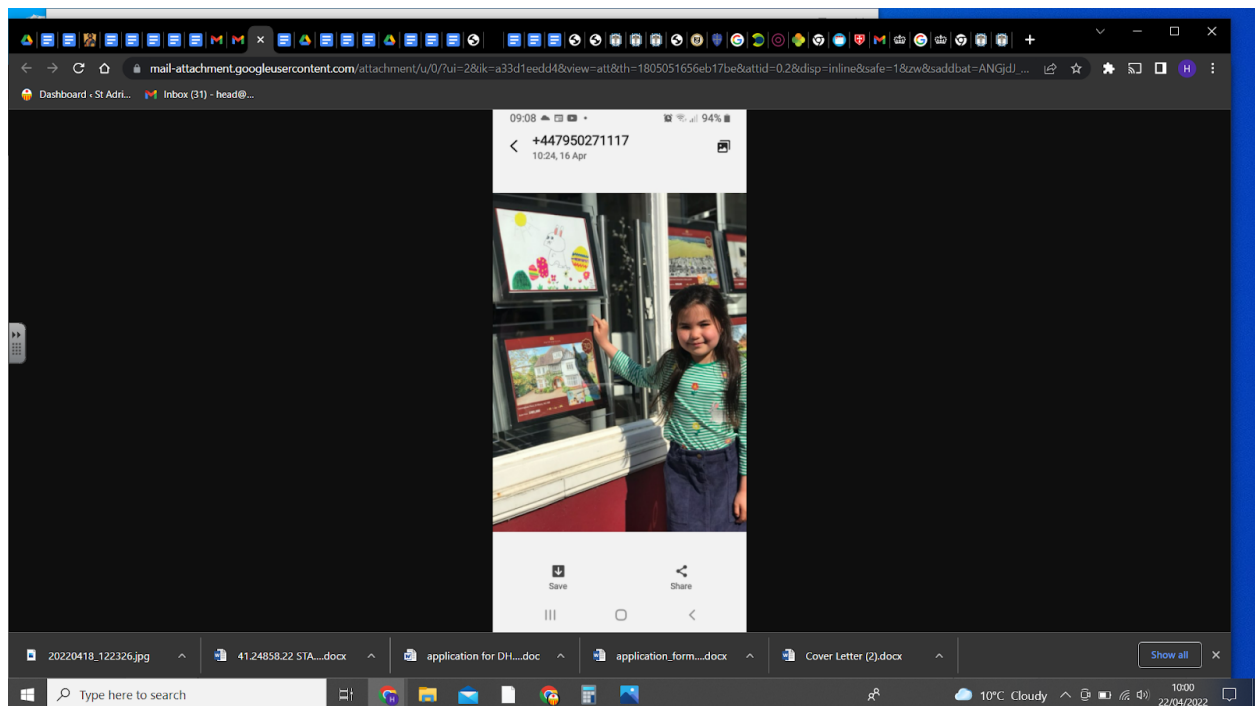
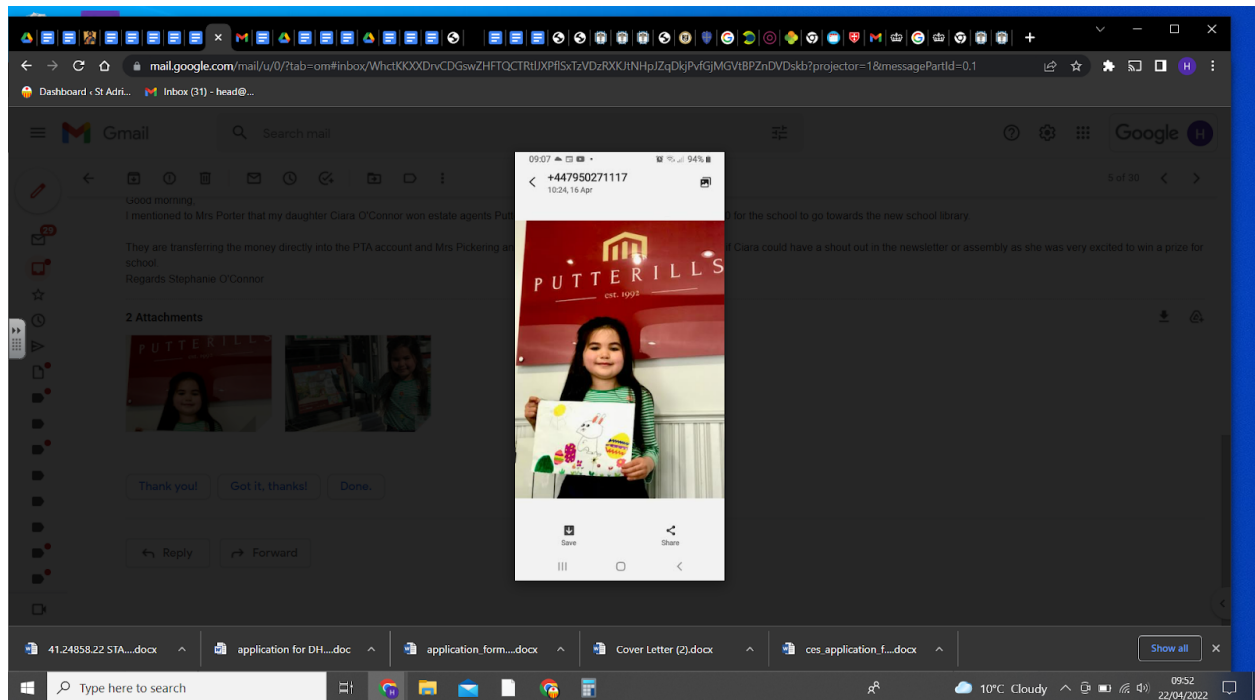
