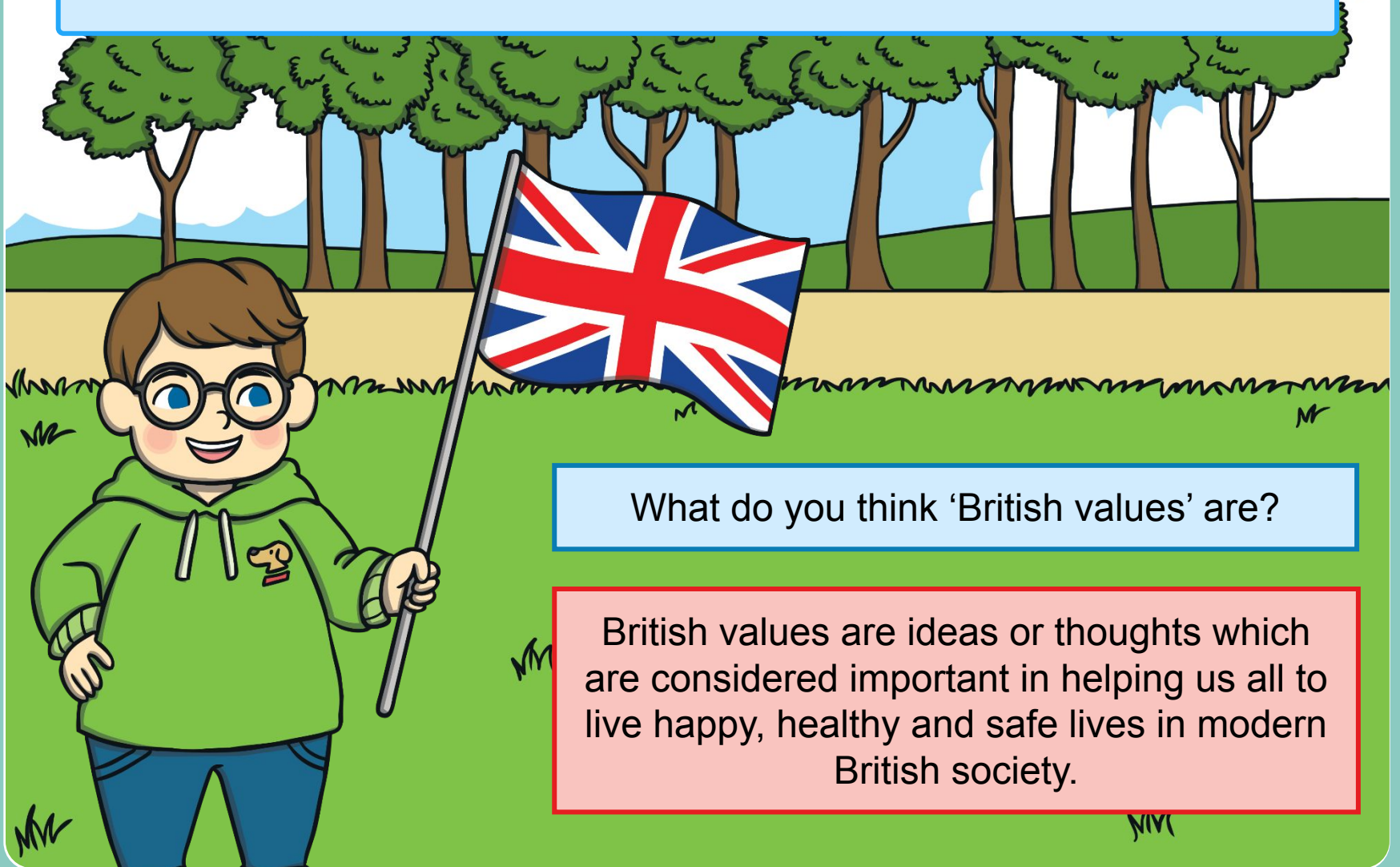

Individual Liberty

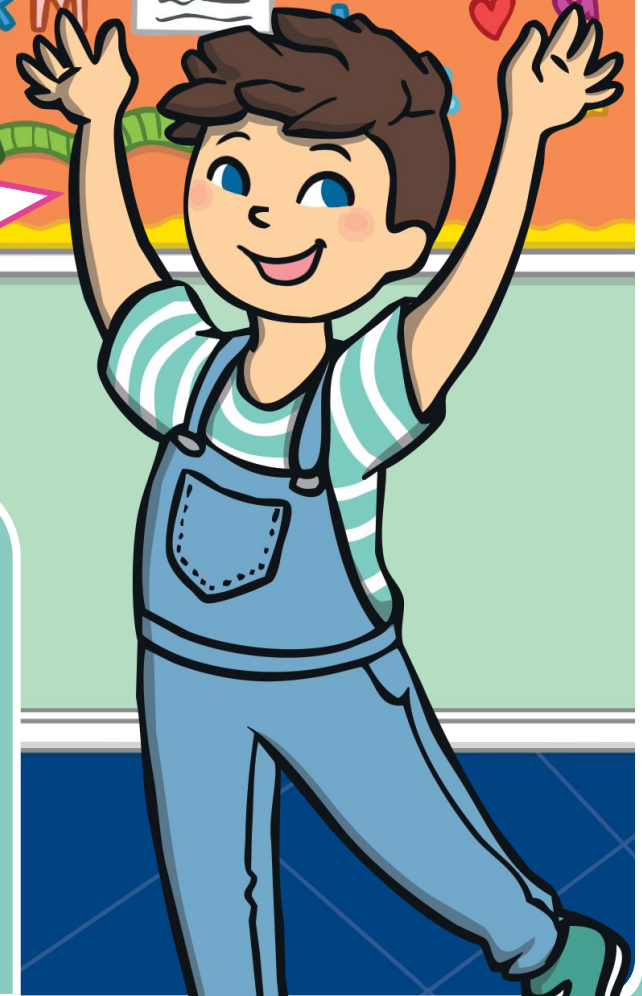
Mutual Respect and Tolerance of Those with Different Faiths and Beliefs

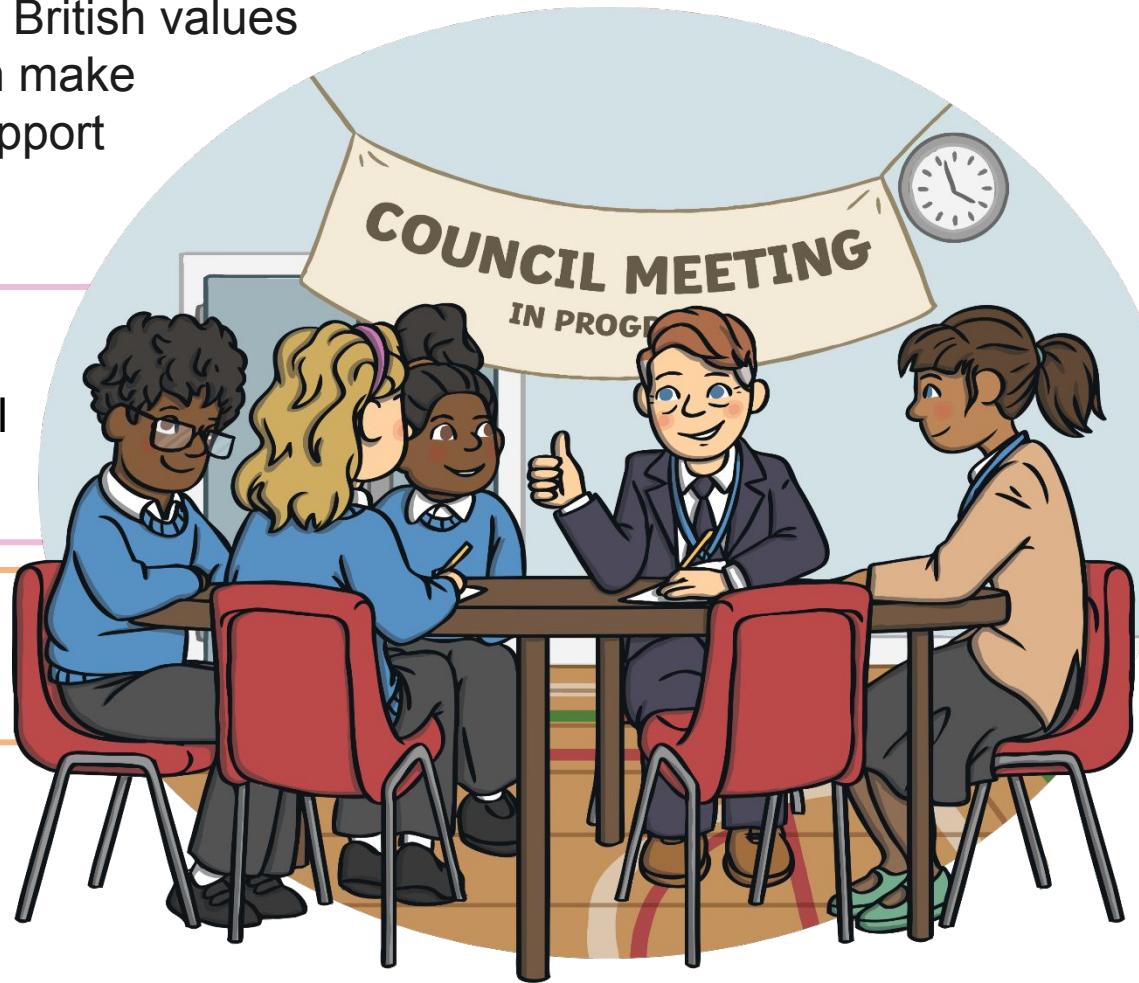
Mutual liberty is to have freedom of choice and to respectfully express your views and opinions in a safe environment. It helps you to feel good about decisions.
