# YR 3 AND 4 SCIENCE WORKSHOP - Report by Savannah

On Thursday the 21st of March we had a science workshop. There were four different stations. Everyone got into partners and we each went to a table . On some of the tables we had explosions and some were experiments . We learnt that if you mix vinegar and carbonate sugar into a bottle then a balloon would blow up. What happens when you put colours in water?

When you put a big blob of 4 different colours then you put it in water you find out what colours make that colour. How do you make something like lava lamps? You have to put water in a cup then you add vinegar, after that you put your food colouring in but then you add salt in you then stir it like a cup of tea bubbles should come up then. What can scratch against wood? We tried different objects against wood to see if it scratched the wood. A lot of people liked making the lava lamps but others liked blowing the balloons up, and some people liked doing the colours and others liked finding out what can scratch wood. We had some adults helpers and lots of teachers and stem point workers stem stands for science, technology, engineering and maths. We all worked together as a team.
